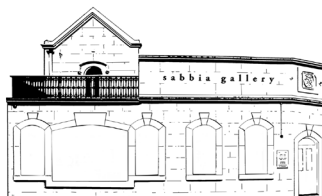

Following on from the success of Cobi's 2011 *esse* exhibition at Sabbia Gallery, with the entire show being acquired for the Art Gallery of WA collection, we are thrilled to be bringing you her newest body of work.
